March 24, 2024 John 12:12-19 Real, Real Gone

INTRODUCTION: The crowd was infatuated with Jesus. Though within the week most of the crowd would turn on him, at the urging of the Pharisees, who were not real, real gone about him, this passage does show us that there are some things about Jesus for which we should genuinely give thanks, things about which he is real for us.

A. Whoa, what in the world does "propitiation" me	ean?

CONCLUSION: Every fellowship should understand that it is only as we give ourselves to Jesus in gratitude that we become far, far more than just another little church on another little corner wondering if there is anything great or fine we will ever be asked to do for the Lord. If Jesus has really gone this route for us, then if we are to be true to our calling, you and me, then we must be real gone for him as well.

## Invite a Friend to Easter Service Try These Five Tips for Inviting a Friend to Church:

- 1. Pray before inviting someone. Ask the Holy Spirit to prompt you if you should invite someone. While you could go and ask everyone you know, it's not as effective as intentional invitations.
- 2. Ask them if they would like to go WITH you. Don't throw an open invite, but instead offer to meet them:
  - Outside the main entrance of the church
  - o In the lobby of your church
  - o At your home, so you can carpool together.
  - o Offer to meet in the parking lot and walk in together.
  - o Offer to meet before or after for a shared meal.
- 3. Explain what it will look like.
  - o Is there a "dress code"? (Casual is fine)
  - o Should they bring a Bible, or will there be extras?
  - o Will they have to introduce themselves? (No)
  - o Which door should they enter if you aren't meeting?
  - How long will the service be? (50-65 Minutes long)
  - o Are they expected to tithe? (No, but make it clear).
  - o Take away as much of the unknown as possible.
- 4. Be by their side as they fearfully step into the unknown. Your presence will comfort them and give them the strength to see for themselves what church is about.
- 5. Follow up. If they attended church, follow up and ask what they thought? Are they interested in attending again? Did they have questions or concerns? Do they know where to start next? Getting them to church is a huge victory, but there is still work to be done. Our goal is to bring people to Christ, not just the Church.

Once you've invited your friend, and they've attended church, help them uncover the next steps. Remember, our purpose is to bring people to Christ, not just church.
